What is Invisalign®?

Invisalign® is a world class teeth straightening treatment that has straightened over 14 million smiles. It uses a set of clear removable aligners to straighten the teeth. They are practically invisible when you smile. They are one of the most discreet treatments available to adults. Unlike other 'at home' options, this treatment and your journey is followed and monitored closely by our trained dentists.



What is the process?

We would advise you to come in for a consultation to meet one of our cosmetic dentists. At the consultation, they will assess whether this treatment, or another, would be suitable for you, and put together a

treatment plan. If so, we will then take a scan so that Invisalign® can produce a Clincheck®. This is a genius piece of 3D technology gives you a visual simulation how your teeth are predicted to move, week by week. Once you are happy to proceed, you would have the aligners fitted. You will be given a set of aligners all numbered in order of wear. You will be asked to change them weekly, unless told otherwise. You will come back every 6 to 8 weeks to make sure everything is on track.

Who is suitable for this treatment?

This treatment is suitable for just about any adult who wants to straighten their teeth cosmetically. This includes people who have crowded, gapped, or misaligned teeth.

People often like this treatment because it allows for flexibility around your lifestyle. The aligners have to be worn around 22 hours a day. They can be taken out for special occasions. They must be taken out to eat and drink anything other than water. But,

you have to remember to put them back in or it may delay the treatment.

The treatment can take anywhere between 7 weeks (i7) through to 14 weeks (Lite) and up to 2 years (Full) but the majority of patients will complete treatment within 4 to 6 months.
