

Bamboo and Veneers - Emax by First Fit

What are Emax Veneers?

Emax Veneers are a type of dental veneer made from a block of Emax porcelain which is a highly aesthetic durable material. They are used to change the colour, shape, length or size of your existing teeth. A true smile makeover. They can also be made very thin (approx. 0.5mm) which means that only a minimal amount of preparation is needed to the healthy teeth. If they are well taken care of, they can last upwards of 15 years.

Who is First Fit?

First Fit (facilitated by the Dental Excellence lab in Liverpool) are a revolutionary lab in the production of veneers. Their veneers service allows patients to have a life-changing smile transformation via a same day process.

What is the process?

The process of having veneers is an exciting one. And this treatment is even more exciting. Once a treatment plan has been put together between you and your dentist, we will take some scans of your teeth. These will be sent to the lab along with the before photos. First Fit will examine them and use the scans/moulds to create the smile digitally.

You will come in for a 'try-in' appointment to try on the models of your veneers. You will be able to walk around the surgery look in the mirror, take some pictures, before giving the go ahead. They can be altered until you are happy, but usually it's right first time. We will then give the lab the go ahead to make the veneers, which usually takes around 4 weeks.

Now it's time for your appointment. Your dentist will place a stent over your teeth to start preparing them for the veneers. The actual veneers will then be placed over your teeth with some temporary glue. This again allows you to look in the mirror, walk around, get comfortable with them before they are fitted. Once you are 100% happy with them, we will proceed with fitting your veneers.

What's the difference between this Emax Veneers treatment and the others?

Once you have decided to proceed, this treatment takes just one sitting to complete. You walk in with your current smile and walk out with your new one. The 'prep' and 'fit' appointments are done together rather than in two separate appointments. This usually takes under three hours.

Who is this treatment suitable for?

If you are interested in having veneers, we first establish whether this would be a suitable treatment for you. Veneers are best suited to people who already have straight teeth. This means that only a minimum amount of preparation is needed. Finally, we will go through your expectations. Having veneers is a permanent treatment; therefore, we will discuss what you want to achieve and ensure that you are happy, both physically and mentally. This particular treatment may be for people who live further away and want to minimise travel times or people who want the ease of having it done in one session.
